

Proposal for Congregational Meeting:

The Elder Board would like to propose the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, dated 1963, to remove Sudan Interior Mission as sole recipient in the event of church dissolution. This will be voted on at the Annual meeting next Sunday night.

Current Statement

That said Articles be further amended by adding thereto the following: "Article 10. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any donor, member, director or officer of the corporation or any private individual and no donor, member, director or officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporation assets. Upon dissolution, any assets of the corporation must be distributed to the SUDAN INTERIOR MISSION, if it then exist and is exempt from Federal Income Tax otherwise to one or more organizations recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as one organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes.

Proposed Amendment

Dissolution Clause. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United State Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
